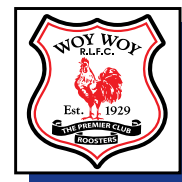

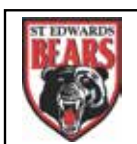

# RUGBY LEAGUE CENTRAL COAST ADOPTION OF AMENDED NSWRL TOUGH LOVE IN LEAGUE POLICY



THE FOLLOWING STANDARD PENALTIES WILL BE APPLIED FOR BREACHES  
OF THE TOUGH LOVE IN LEAGUE POLICY:

## PLAYER OFFENCES

Referee Abuse (Low)	Minimum 2 match suspension and 1 competition point
Referee Abuse (Medium)	Minimum 4 match suspension and 2 competition points
Referee Abuse (High)	Minimum 6 match suspension and 2 competition points
Referee Abuse (Serious)	Minimum 12 match suspension and 2 competition points
Bench player entering the field and involved in fight	Minimum 6 week suspension and 2 competition points
Player leaving playing area to be involved in a fight	Minimum 6 week suspension and 2 competition points

## TEAM OFFENCES

Two or more players from one team involved in a fight (First offence)	Match deem forfeit to non-offending side - \$1000 bond
Two or more players from both teams involved in a fight (First Offence)	Match deemed abandoned - \$1000 bond per team
Three or more players from one team involved in a fight	As above plus 2 competition points
Two or more players from any team involved in a fight (second offence)	Players/ officials may be DISQUALIFIED for the season
Any team breach of policy in a FINALS series match	Team DISQUALIFIED for remainder of the series

## TEAM OFFICIAL OFFENCES

Official leaving the playing area to become involved in a fight	Minimum 6 week suspension
Touching a referee or official in aggressive manner	Minimum 12 month suspension and 2 competition points
Referee Abuse (High/ Serious)	Minimum 12 month suspension

## SPECTATOR OFFENCES

Spectator illegally enters field of play	Minimum 12 months suspension, plus 2 competition points
Unsportsmanlike comments to any participant (Low/ Medium)	Match deem forfeit to non-offending side - \$1000 bond
Unsportsmanlike comments to any participant (High/ Serious)	Minimum 12 month suspension, plus above
Unsportsmanlike comments to any participant (second offence)	Team DISQUALIFIED for remainder of the season
Referee Abuse (High/ Serious)	Minimum 12 month suspension and 3 competition points

## CLUB OFFENCES

Failure to supply video (if used) and/ or identify club offender.	Team concerned will be disqualified until person/s identified

*Note: These penalties are applied following the outcome of the NSWRL Judiciary and/ or Code of Conduct investigations process.*

## **NATIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT**

*Clubs are responsible for the conduct of their players, parents/carers of players, coaches, officials and spectators.*

*No person(s) attending a match, function, or Club related event or activity shall:*

- A. *Use offensive or obscene language to any participant.*
- B. *Enter the Field of Play or the Playing Area during the course of a match without the prior approval of the Ground Manager appointed by the home Club and/or League.*
- C. *Excessively dispute the decision of a Referee or Touch Judge either during or after a match.*
- D. *Assault, or act with aggression, to any person/s.*
- E. *Behave in a way contrary to the Code of Conduct and/or the spirit of the game.*
- F. *Behave in a way which disturbs the enjoyment of a match, function, activity or event by any person/s, or brings discredit to any Club, League or the game.*
- G. *Act in such a way as to exhibit racial intolerance, by language or other conduct, to any person/s.*
- H. *Refuse to accept the reasonable direction of the Ground Manager, official of the team/ Club which that person is supporting, or official of the home Club and/or League.*
- I. *No person/s may make comment or take actions that bring discredit to any person, Club or league through any social media outlet.*

*Clubs are responsible for the conduct of their players, parents/carers of players, coaches, officials and Club supporters.*

*Breaches of the Rugby League Code of Conduct may result in penalties, including but not limited to:*

- » *Suspension of a match and/or*
- » *Termination of a match (including potential forfeiture of competition points) and/or*
- » *Monetary fines and/or*
- » *Suspension of a participant on a temporary or permanent basis and/or*
- » *Suspension of a Club, League or Association on a temporary or permanent basis.*

*These penalties are in addition to any penalty which may be imposed by the relevant governing League bodies.*
